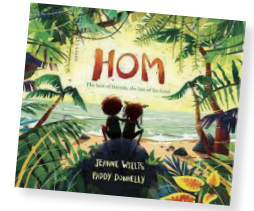


Whole Book Class Reading Suggestions

In this intriguing story, a shipwrecked boy discovers a very unusual friend, and changes his mind about what he has lost and where he belongs. *Picturebook*



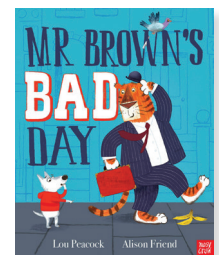
Nop by Caroline Magerl, published by Walker Books

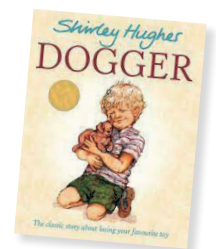
Mr Brown's Bad Day by Lou Peacock, illustrated by Alison Friend, published by Nosy Crow
